Antitrust Claim Against *TMC FleetPortal*TM Withdrawn

Alexandria, VA – Service Professionals, Inc. has withdrawn its complaint against American Trucking Associations, Inc. and Continental DataGraphics in which it had alleged anti-competitive and exclusionary activities related to the ATA's Technology and Maintenance Council service offering of *TMC FleetPortal*TM. In response to the complaint filed by SPI in the United States District Court for the Western District of New York in May 2005, both ATA and CDG filed motions to dismiss strongly denying any type of anticompetitive behavior or antitrust concern, and pointed out that SPI had failed to state a claim recognized under the law. Rather than respond to ATA's and CDG's filings, SPI withdrew its complaint on August 23.

Carl Kirk, vice president of ATA councils and TMC Executive Director, said, "We are pleased that this legal challenge has been removed. We believe that *TMC FleetPortal*TM delivers efficiency to the trucking industry and other transport operators by streamlining maintenance functions and we will continue to market this valuable service."
